> Dorton House School, Sevenoaks, Kent

Dorton House School provides education for children aged 2-16 who have visual impairments and learning difficulties, sometimes severe. It uses adapted teaching techniques and special teaching materials to meet their special educational needs which may include mobility training, key boarding, braille technology and daily living skills. Volunteers spend their time in different departments within the school, nursery and residential areas, with tasks including: assisting children with personal care (feeding, cleaning, bathing etc.), helping teachers and supervising leisure activities (swimming, horse riding and after-school clubs). Volunteering is divided between time at the school during the day and time in the residential units, where the pupils live, during the mornings/evenings.
