> Peterhouse School, Southport

Peterhouse School is an independent school for **children aged between 5 and 19 with autism and associated learning difficulties and challenging behaviour**. Volunteers assist with physical education, music, life skills and general classroom activity, as well as elements of personal care.

During outings, volunteers assist the students in social interaction and general communication with other members of the community. Children with autism tend to have a lack of interest in social interaction, so building a rapport with the students over time will be a priority for those volunteering at this placement.

Peterhouse School is an ideal project for those wanting to learn more about autism, and those with a strong interest in working with children, music, sport, or similar activities.
